1. General information about the event and stage location

This festival will present live music and dance performances on the stage of the Lavazza IncluCity Festival in Distillery District, Toronto, on July 1st, 2026, at 6:45 pm, and on July 2nd, 2026, at 5:30 pm. The duration of each show is 75 minutes.

There will be an open space in front of the stage, and comfy chair provided by the Festival.

Event description:

This Women in Song concert series is part of the Lavazza IncluCity Festival. Inaugurated as a grassroots non-profit film festival in 2012, ICFF has developed into a multidisciplinary and multicultural organization that embraces all facets of the arts. Stage location:

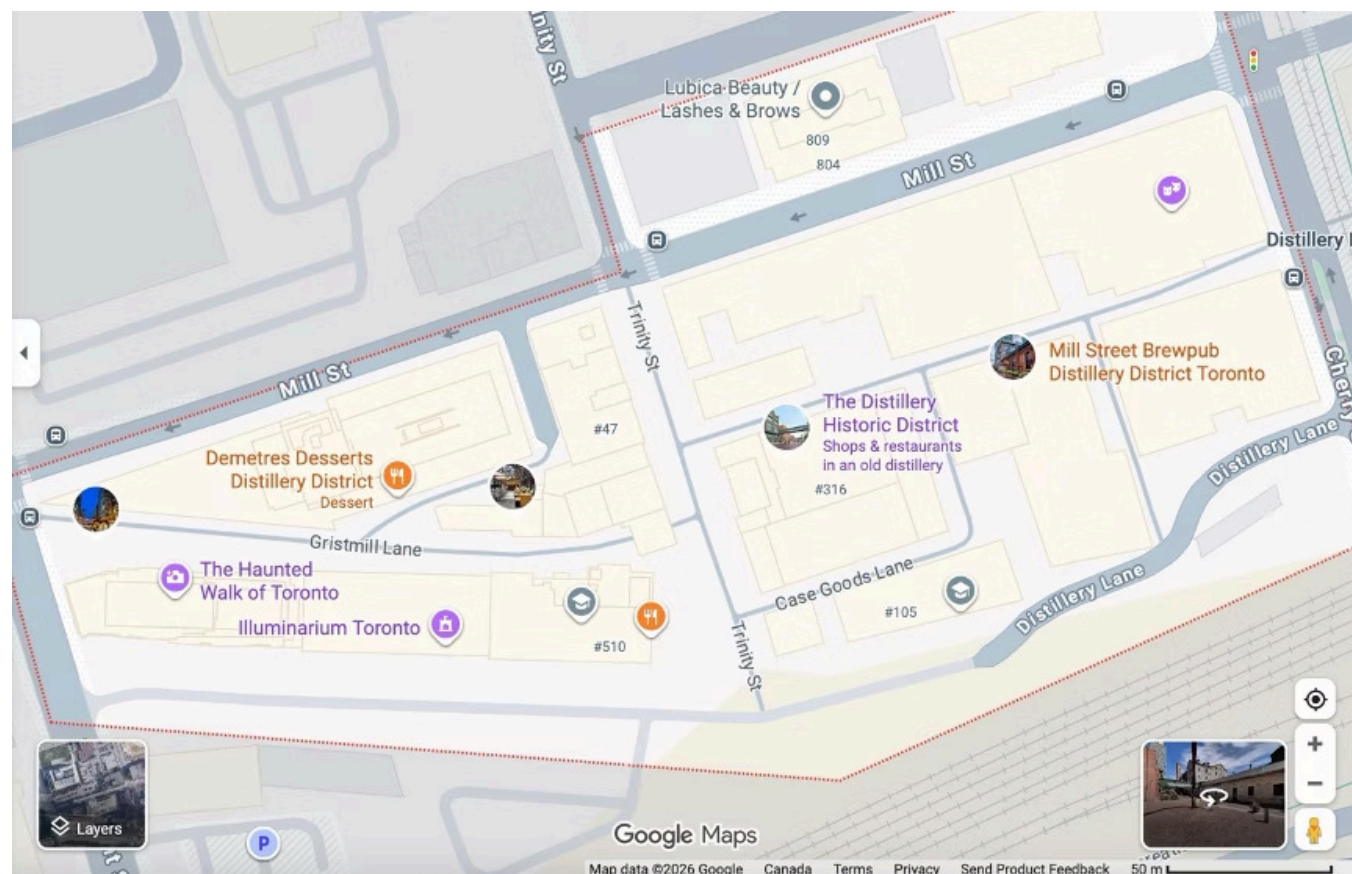
The stage of the Lavazza IncluCity Festival where FabCollab's Women in Song concert will take place is located at the Old Clock Tower, where Gristmill Lane and Trinity Street meet.

2. Venue Information and Map

The Distillery District is located in Downtown Toronto, Ontario, Canada, just east of the city center. Known for its 19th-century Victorian industrial architecture and cobblestone pedestrian-only streets, the district is a vibrant hub of boutiques, galleries, and dining.

The main pedestrian entrance is located at 55 Mill Street in Toronto. A link to the PDF map of the District is available below.

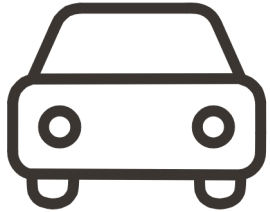

3. Arriving at the Venue by car, Wheel-Trans, rideshare or taxi

With construction and condo development in the area, parking is very limited. The best way to travel to The Distillery District is to take public transit, taxi or rideshare.

Wheel-Trans users need to be registered before planning trips. More information at <https://www.ttc.ca/wheel-trans/how-to-apply>.

Closest Parking Facilities:

Street parking is available in the district but difficult to find, especially for wheelchair accessible parking.

Green P parking lots are available in the district with limited parking, and limited number of wheelchair accessible spots.

Green P Parking At the Distillery District

- 70 Distillery Lane Garage (Green P #267): Underground parking accessible from Cherry Street.
- 31A Parliament Street (Green P #230): Surface lot located at the north entrance of the Distillery District.

Green P Parking in the area

- 100 Cooperage Street (Green P #283): Underground parking just a short 2-minute walk away.
- 40 Rolling Mills Road (Green P #285): Surface lot located slightly east of the district.

Drop-off (taxi or Wheel-Trans)

The festival recommends using the Guardhouse Entrance (55 Mill Street) for TTC Wheel-Trans services.



4. Arriving at the Venue by transit

You can reach Distillery District by streetcar or by bus. Both modes have accessible seating.

Before your trip, we recommended that you look at the service alerts and accessibility alerts to make sure the service is working correctly.

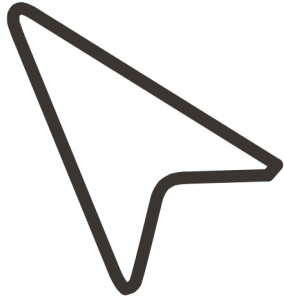
Streetcar

The closest streetcar stop to the district is located at King Street East at Parliament Street, served by streetcars 503 and 504. To go to Distillery District from the streetcar stop, head South on Parliament Street for 5 minutes and take the entrance at the intersection of Parliament Street and Mill Street. Follow the Gristmill Lane pedestrian street until the old clock tower, where the festival is located.

Alternatively, the 504 continues to a stop called Distillery Loop located on the other side of the Distillery District, at the intersection of Mill Street and Cherry Street. From there, enter the site through Tank House Lane and continue to the clock tower.

Bus

The closest bus stops to the district are located at Mill Street at Parliament Street, and Mill Street at Cherry Street West Side, both served by bus 121D. The entrance to Distillery District is just south of each bus stop.



5. Entering and Navigating Inside the Venue

The Distillery District is an accessible site and provides for mobility-accessible parking, ramp access to buildings, shops and restaurants. While the pedestrian streets can be navigated using mobility aid devices, the historic streets inside the District are made of cobblestone and are naturally uneven in some locations.

Service animals are welcome in the District, outside and in the stores and galleries.

Public accessible washrooms with child changing facilities and wheelchair accessible stalls are available in the District. Note that washroom layouts vary, and all washrooms don't have door openers.

Individual venues on-site, such as the Cacao 70 Distillery or the Spirit of York Distillery Company, feature highly spacious, individual accessible washrooms with grab bars and lowered amenities.

Accessible restaurants

6.1. Pure Spirits Oyster House & Grill

Entrance/Interior:

- Main entrance is wide enough to allow safe passage of persons who use mobility aids.
- There is no automatic door opener.
- Level path to main dining room.
- Some areas of the dining room are not wheelchair accessible; however, alternative wheelchair-accessible seating is available.
- The bar is not wheelchair accessible.

Washrooms:

- Public designated accessible washroom stalls are available.
- There is no automatic door opener.

6.2. El Catrin

Entrance/Interior:

- Main entrance is wide enough to allow safe passage of persons who use mobility aids.
- Main entrance has an automatic door opener.
- Level path to main dining room.
- Some areas of the dining room are not wheelchair accessible; however, alternative wheelchair-accessible seating is available.
- The bar is not wheelchair accessible.

Washrooms:

- Designated accessible washroom stalls are available.
- There is no automatic door opener.

6.3. Cluny Bistro & Boulangerie

Entrance/Interior:

- Main entrance is wide enough to allow safe passage of persons who use mobility aids.
- There is no automatic door opener
- Level path to main dining room.
- Some areas of the dining room are not wheelchair accessible; however, alternative wheelchair-accessible seating is available.
- The oyster bar is wheelchair accessible.
- The lounge bar is not wheelchair accessible.

Washrooms

- Designated accessible washroom stalls are available.
- There is no automatic door opener.

6.4. Madrina Bar y Tapas

Entrance/Interior:

- Main entrance is wide enough to allow safe passage of persons who use mobility aids.
- There is no automatic door opener.
- Level path to main dining room.
- Some areas of the dining room are not wheelchair accessible; however, alternative wheelchair-accessible seating is available.
- The bar is not wheelchair accessible.

Washrooms:

- Designated accessible washroom stalls are available.
- There is no automatic door opener.

6.5. Archeo

Entrance/Interior:

- Main entrance is wide enough to allow safe passage of persons who use mobility aids.
- There is no automatic door opener.
- Level path to main dining room.

Washrooms

- Designated accessible washroom stalls are available.
- There is no automatic door opener.

6.6. District Pizza

Entrance/Interior

- Main entrance is wide enough to allow safe passage of persons who use mobility aids.
- There is no automatic door opener.

Washrooms

- Public designated accessible washroom stalls are available.
- There is no automatic door opener.

6.7. Jardin

Entrance/Interior:

- Main entrance is wide enough to allow safe passage of persons who use mobility aids.
- Main entrance has an automatic door opener.
- Dining room is fully accessible.

Washrooms:

- Public designated accessible washroom stalls are available.
- There is no automatic door opener.
